There is no 912 to call in an emergency......

In his position as the Emergency Response and Communication Director of Cortland County Scott Roman, and Deputy Director Courtney Metcalf, explained to us that while their work is essential to the community, that it is their best interest if it remains unheralded.

The job encompasses the 911 Call Center, Emergency Management and Fire Coordinator; they not only dispatch 25 agencies in Cortland County, but are also part of a state wide network. The Fire Coordinator is in charge of the Fire Fighter Training Center; this is Courtney's department, which has had 500 graduates, at a 98% graduation rate.

Communications, which encompasses 911, is a 24 hours a day, seven days a week operation. They have three people on call all the time, and work with surrounding counties when calls exceed that. The most common calls are domestic, with many law enforcement and medical calls. They are busy every day from 10am to 6pm, and peak on Sunday mornings when the college is in session.
