CBR was joined this week by City of Cortland Police Department's K-9 Officer Kristyn Drake and her partner Kort! Drake has been an officer for five years and in the K-9 Unit for three. Kort, the hard-working, yet incredibly social Belgian Malinois that serves as Officer Drake's partner, came from Holland where he received his first six weeks of training as a police dog. Kort then underwent an additional six weeks conjoined training together with Officer Drake at Shallow Creek Kennels. The duo now serves in the Cortland community detecting narcotics that includes heroin, cocaine, meth, fentanyl, and MDMA; as well as apprehending suspects, locating missing persons and sniffing out articles that might be considered evidence. Just last year Kort was invaluable in helping to locate a student missing from Smith School, picking up the trail from the smell of the child's backpack, and despite the area being contaminated with the scents of all the other teachers & students- an incredible display of his skills!

Upon first meeting Kort, Officer Drake was nervous to pet him, but Kort proved to be very loving and a bond was formed almost instantly. According to Drake, the dog loves people, is great with kids, and has a current obsession with "apprehending" squirrels. Fortunately, Officer Drake was able to train Kort out of a similar drive to go after deer.

The equipment used by the K-9 Unit are usually donated or purchased by donated funds, so the City of Cortland Police Dept. expresses their gratitude for the support generously provided by the Cortland Breakfast Rotary Club.
