Cortland Breakfast Rotary welcomed guest speaker Jack Day, a fellow Rotarian who currently serves as Vice President of Meals of Hope.

Meals of Hope's mission is "To inspire and empower communities to come together to end hunger," and is differentiated by a priority to keep the packed meals within the United States, primarily donated to the Feeding America Food Bank Network.

Jack Day expressed to the club that Meals of Hope is significant in that it does more than feed families, but is a community service project that transforms teams and strengthens communities, creating an even greater wave of impact.

In New York State, 2.8 million residents experience food insecurity, and almost 10% of the population of Cortland County is food insecure. Meals of Hope provides an opportunity for clubs like CBR to demonstrate that they walk the walk of being a community service organization. On August 2^{nd} , CBR will have the opportunity to participate in a meal packing event along with the Noon Rotary Club, Kiwanis Clubs, and the Cortland Community Service Club.
