Denise and Bryan explained their jobs, about what a County Coroner does. It is an elected position, and by no means is it easy work. They reach out to the community, talking to schools and community groups. The most important traits for a Coroner are empathy and understanding. People are at their most vulnerable when a loved one passes. The Coroner doesn't just deal with a death, but with a family. Last year there were 115 deaths in the County, 17 of them were drug overdoses. The drug problem is worse than people imagine, and crosses over levels of age and income. They usually work with a police agency, but the job can take weeks or months. Thank you, Denise and Bryan, for the important and difficult work that you do.
