Cliff Carey was exposed to Rotary

When he volunteered in Peru to help individuals with hearing loss, and worked with several Rotary Clubs in that country. Cortland Hearing Aids was founded twenty years ago, and has branched out to include offices in Elmira and Watkins Glen. It services twenty counties in New York and eight in Pennsylvania, treating 1012 patients a month.

Healthy Hearing is Healthy Aging.

Cliff explained how the loss of hearing increases dementia; also, if you can't hear the chance of your falling down and suffering bodily harm increases three times. Hearing is crucial to our cognition: our ears collect data and our brain interprets this information. We hear with two ears and one brain! The fewer details that the brain receives the harder it works to make sense of it.

Hearing aids have greatly improved—

There are more computers in a hearing aid than in the original lunar rover! Cliff explained that although there are a lot of hearing products in the market, none of them are yet FDA approved. While doing something is better than doing nothing, Cliff suggested that we work with a professional to assess what our needs may be. Do we need hearing aids or a ear wax removal? They have an array of hearing aids for all kinds of needs and price ranges, and provide financing for anyone who prefers it.


