Brendan is a Chenango County native. He currently lives in Binghamton and is house shopping in our area. He has been instrumental in bringing millions of dollars to small businesses in Broome County and hopes to do the same in Cortland County.

Brendan talked about the many ways the IDA and BDC helps to attract, grow and retain businesses with possible abatements, loans, site selections and SBDC consultations helping with business planning. He talked about DRI & NY Forward having 2.5 to 4 million in funding.

Apex - waiting for EPA Phase II Environment Study. Once there are final guidelines from the EPA the community can discuss how they want the site to be used.

Micron- waiting on the Federal Government for approval to move forward in our community. If approved there will be Community Funding to help with needs like housing and businesses.

Sports Tourism - Gutchess Park will be a huge boost to Cortland County

Solar Projects - some residential and 2 industrial

iSpice - 25 million dollar project. 2.5 million in new tax revenue over the next 10 years. 350 new employees over the next 3 years. First year to add 175 employees.

Business Assistance Grant \$600,000. Grants for small businesses 75/25.

The IDDA has supported Senior Housing Projects, the Virgil School Project for Seniors ages 55+

Brendan also previously served the Greater Binghamton Chamber of Commerce as Director of Government Relations, and he currently sits on the Board and serves as the Treasurer for the Rural Health Network of South-Central New York.
