Joshua was born in Cortland and raised in Homer, and while a teenager he started volunteering at the County Historical Society, which eventually led him to become the Archivist for the City of Philadelphia.

The Archive is the memory, the place to go for first hand materials. Because the Archives are primarily paper based, it has 22,000 boxes—about 200 tons of paper!

The Archives have 3000 visitors a year, mainly genealogists, property researchers, professors, and students. Most of the materials are stored on high density shelves and flat files, and can be accessed with finding aids and shelf lists. They have William Penn's charter of 1701, deeds from the 1600's, signatures of Hamilton and Franklin, among others. They allow research on-site or prepaid off-site; most of the material is paper, although they have over 400 films. Thank you, Joshua, for letting us see your important work!
