Puzzle Solvers was founded in 2009 by Kimberly Friedman, Nicki Wynn, and Jackie Newton to provide compassion to families with autism, and to help realize autism's unique abilities. It helps to give families a voice, with the chance to meld into society and hope for the future.

Hilary Dwyer is a local speech-language pathologist who was drawn to the mission of Puzzle Solvers. Ryder Wynn was diagnosed with autism at the age of 3, who had family members who helped and advocated for his needs. He relayed how he was used to a routine, and would panic when the routine was disrupted.

An important facet of Puzzle Solvers is Connecting Caregivers, which not only assists caregivers and other professionals, but also provides an Autism Parent Support Group. Puzzle Solvers does not receive support from the government, which means it does a lot of fundraising. It holds a golf tournament every September, merchandise in April for Autism Awareness month, and raffles throughout the year. It also works with the Racker Center, and is teaming up with Access to Independence.

Puzzle Solvers is a local 501 C3 who have been in our community to assist local people and families with Autism in a variety of different ways including support financially, socially, and connecting families with local resources. Two of the members of their volunteer team include Hilary Dwyer, M.S. CCC-SLP, and Ryder Wynn.

Hilary Dwyer is a local speech-language pathologist who completed her Bachelor's of Science in Speech and Hearing Science in 2017, and her Master's of Science in Communication Disorders and Sciences in 2020 both from SUNY Cortland. Ryder Wynn is currently dual majoring in the honors program for both History and Anthropology with a strong interest in Museum Studies at SUNY Cortland. Ryder has been a member of Puzzle Solvers for a majority of his life, as his mother Nicki Wynn, serves as VP and is one of the original founders. Both Ryder and Hilary work with Puzzle Solvers to help families in the community build a network of resources through various different activities. Both attend various resource fairs in the community to spread the word, and network about Puzzle Solvers. They also both facilitate last year's newest addition, the Connecting Caregivers Parent Support group that helps pair caregivers with other caregivers in the Cortland community so that they may network with other, share resources, and learn something educationally each meeting. Meetings are dual faceted as they serve for a place to connect and discuss, and gain support, while also offering various activities and information each session from a licensed therapist and many guest speakers on Autism related topics.

Glenn Reisweber is not happy about the lack of snow;


Steve Cinquanti thanked our Speakers and for **Jim Dempsey** and **Mark Roberts** joining our Club in 1993;
