# Rob Bowen Clothing for Vets


When Rob left the military in naval aviation, he had no clothes for civilian life. Today there is a two week transition to civilian life, in 1995 there was none. He realized the Power of the Suit—it becomes a symbol of getting back into civilian life.

While working for his company, Patriotic Insurance Co., he started Suits for Soldiers. With one ad in the paper, he collected 1600 suits in three weeks! Since then, he has had suit drives in businesses, at Rotary Clubs, and has 15-20,000 suits! Some of the best suppliers of suits are New York City detectives. He also talked about with with organizations like the Department of Labor to get veterans back into the workforce. He also deals with the two worst problems in the military—PTSD and suicide. Besides suits, he collects all sorts of clothing for both men and women veterans; in addition, he has access to homeless veterans and does the best he can with them.
