RAISED ON A FARM, OFFICER PERKINS GREW UP WITH ANIMALS, ESPECIALLY DOGS. ALEX EXPLAINED HOW DOGS BRIDGE THE GAP BETWEEN THE POLICE AND THE GENERAL PUBLIC, AND HELP TO DEVELOP A GOOD PARTNERSHIP WITH THE COMMUNITY. MAX IS A SHEPHERD/MALINOWSKI MIX, AND IS 1 1/2 YEARS OLD; HIS BREED USUALLY LIVES UNTIL 11 YEARS OLD, AND WILL BE IN SERVICE UNTIL HE IS 9 YEARS OLD.

ALEX AND MAX ARE A TEAM—NO ONE WORKS WITH MAX BESIDES ALEX. THERE ARE 4 DOGS IN CORTLAND COUNTY, AND THEY COVER 24 HOURS A DAY. THEY ARE TRAINED IN NARCOTICS, APPREHENSION, TRACKING, AND ARTICLE SEARCHING. THE DOG/OFFICER TEAMS UNDERGO REGULAR MAINTENANCE TRAINING ON TUESDAYS.

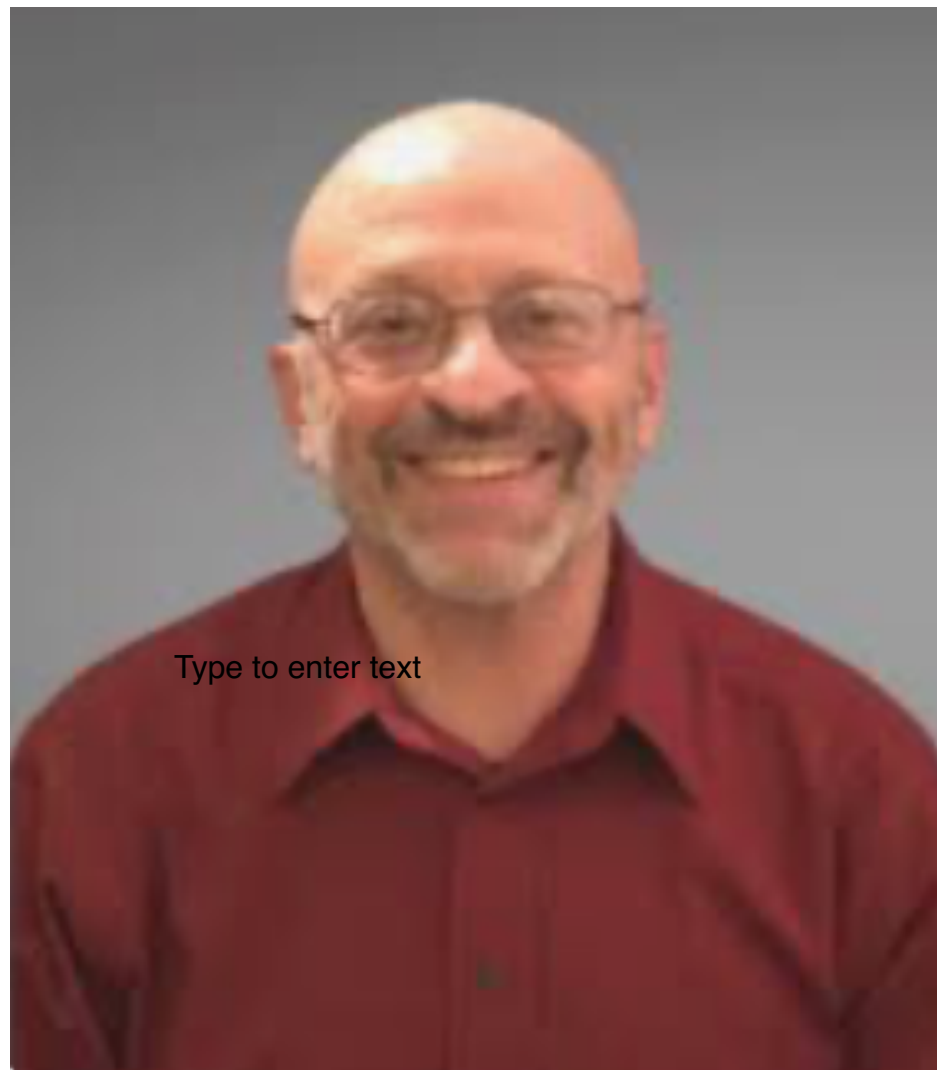
No meeting on November 22!

Conrad Janke announced that the Salvation Army Dollar Drop will be December 16, a sign up sheet will be sent out soon.

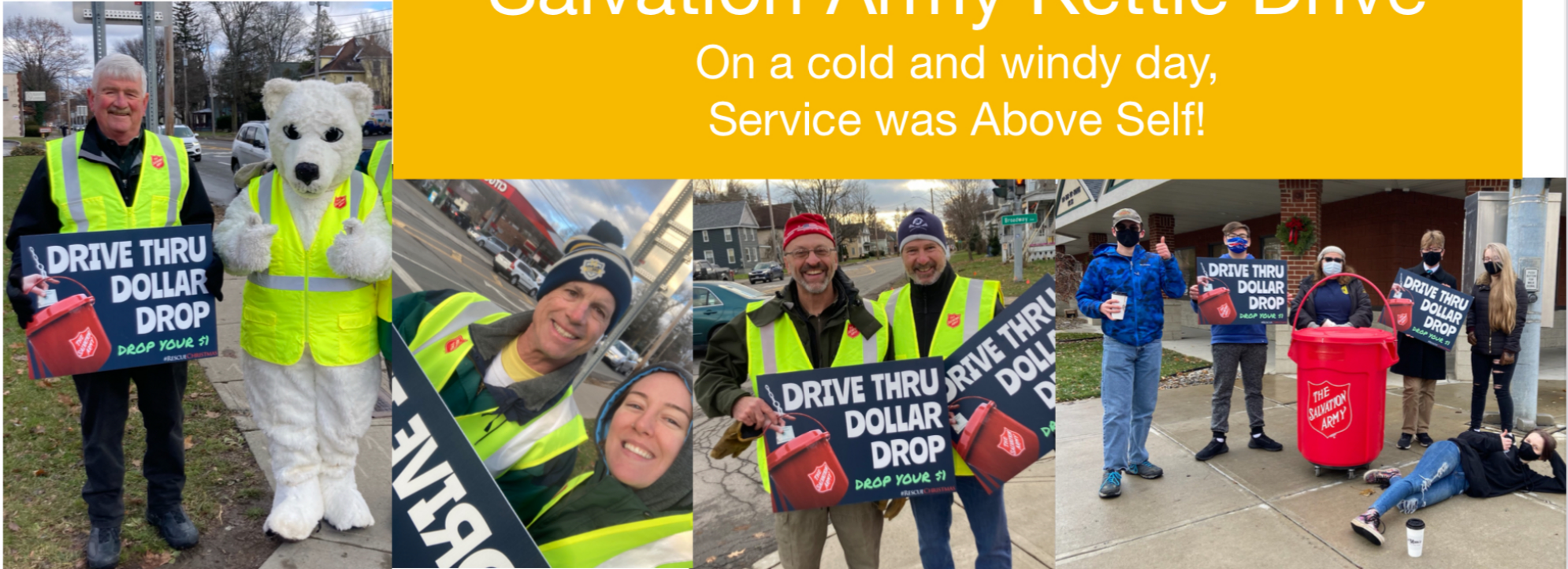
