She determined that there was a lack of leadership, and worked on recruiting and retaining nurses. She hired 100 nurses from the surrounding areas, and cut down the number of traveling nurses from 68 to 6! She wants local nurses, as they know the community, and the community knows them.

Realizing that people don't like to go tot he hospital, she has embraced technology because it improves the level of nursing and makes the nurse's job easier. An example of this is virtual nursing, which she has had very positive experiences with. Kansas mentioned the National nursing shortage is predicted to be at its all time high by 2027. Kansas feels that we can keep our nurses here in our community by relationship building and investing in them. 


