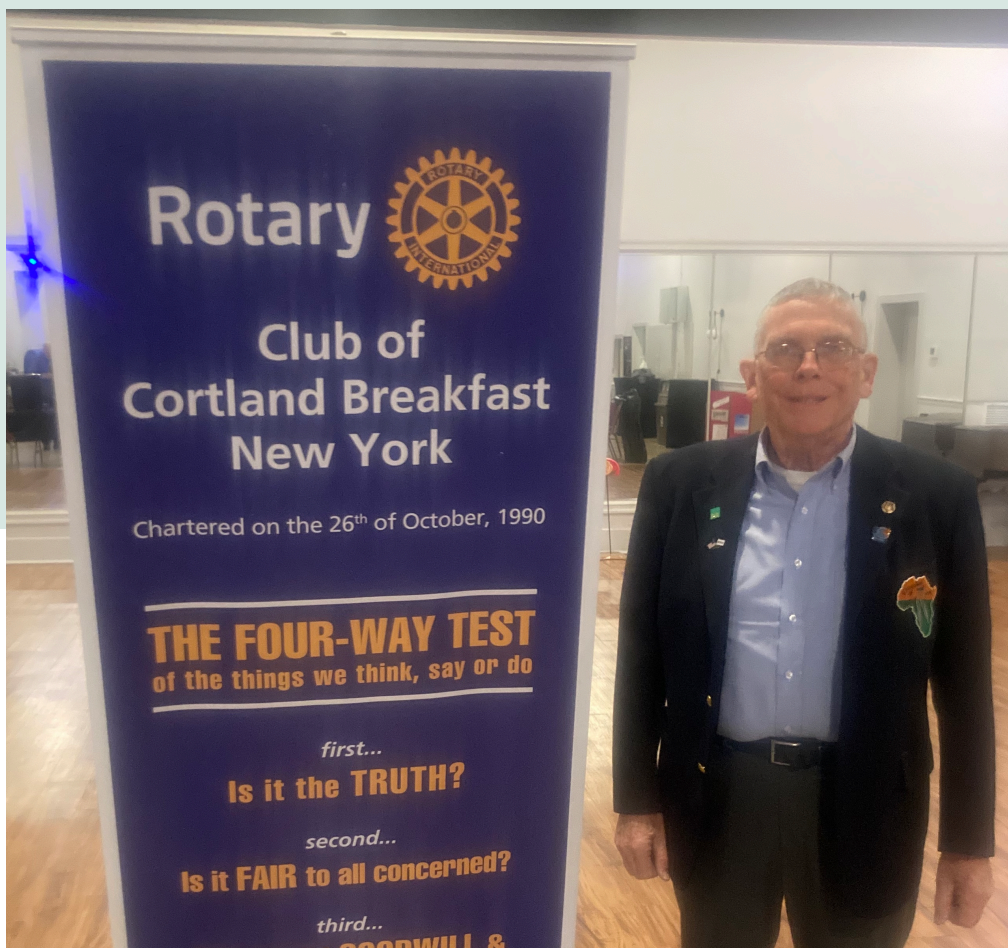

David, a Rotarian and polio survivor in Colorado, saw crutches and wheelchairs on the side of the road. He started collecting them and donated them.

THEY HAVE SHIPPED OVER 188,000 DEVICES

to 26 countries in Africa and 14 countries around the world. The last shipment Richard was involved in was to Pakistan. Over 20 million people in Africa need devices.

THE BIGGEST PROBLEM IS STORING THE CRUTCHES

Also, the cost has gone up tremendously. Some of the other devices they collect are braces, prosthetics, and baby walkers. Richard recommended that we advertise in the media, contact loan closet

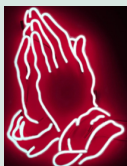
