Good Morning Everyone,

First, thank you for having me here today. I'm honored to share with you something that's very close to my heart — **Little Tags Foundation**.

Little Tags Foundation is a **not-for-profit 501(c)(3) organization**, established in **2020 in memory** of our brother, son, Uncle and friend, Nathan Bush. Out of that personal loss came a deep commitment: to support our youth and their families who value the outdoors, and to help preserve a tradition that brings people together — hunting and fishing.

Our mission is simple but powerful: we provide lifetime hunting and fishing licenses to youth, at no cost to them or their families. This isn't just a piece of paper — it's an invitation into a lifelong connection with nature, family traditions, and outdoor stewardship.

Since we began, we've been able to gift soon to be 200 of these licenses; which is over \$115k and each one comes with a story — a child who can now join their parents or grandparents in the woods during hunting season, a young angler who will always have access to the water, or a family that now has a way to pass down their outdoor heritage without the financial burden.

We believe that the outdoors is more than recreation — it's a way to teach patience, responsibility, respect for the environment, and the value of quality time. And by investing in our youth now, we ensure those traditions and values will be passed on for generations.

Like many nonprofit organizations, we rely on the generosity of our community to continue our work — through donations, partnerships, and simply by spreading the word about what we do.
