A physics grad of SUNY Cortland, Mike started Dragon Solar in 2017. He explained how solar generates DC power, and an inverter turns it into 240 volts.

Mike covered batteries, how solar protects against inflation, and how Dragon can match a monthly loan payment to the electric bill.

The typical Return On Investment is 7 years. When it snows in CNY is when solar is the least productive time of the year; there is but an 8% loss of energy due to the snow, and the solar panels melt the snow quicker than the roof.


